The building has 13 storage tanks installing the vertical pipe work to allow for the progressive shrinkage of this type of building. Extensive work to the buildings services are being carried by Quick Plumbing including the connections to major services in the surrounding streets.

The Centrelink building is a large office building of some 44000 square metres of office space with a large central atrium. It is a premium grade building purpose built for Centrelink. Grey water recycling at 20,000 litres/day used within the building for flushing and outside for garden watering. Two solar arrays to supply at least 50% of hot water requirements. This building is an example of Quick Plumbing's ability to design and build in today's green environment.
